(800) 536-2867		Effective January 1, 2020, Medi-Cal providers became eligible for a \$29 payment for conducting Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) screenings for child and adult patients with full-scope Medi-Cal. Payment is not available for patients age 65 and older or for those who are dually eligible for Medi-Cal and Medicare Part B (regardless of enrollment in Medicare Part A or Part D).
