# Medi-Cal RX Update NDCs Required for Medication Referrals

The purpose of this bulletin is to inform all providers that effective January 1, 2022 certain services for Medi-Cal members are carved out of the Medi-Cal program and included in the Medi-Cal RX Program. Effective immediately NDCs are required on all medication referral requests to determine whether they are self injectables covered under Medi-Cal RX or physician administered drugs (PAD) covered under managed care.

# Referrals for all medications require NDC Code:

- National Drug Code Drugs are identified and reported using a unique number called the National Drug Code (NDC) which serves as the FDA's identifier for drugs.
- FDA publishes the listed NDC numbers in the <u>NDC Directory</u> which is updated daily. The searchable directory is available online (<a href="https://www.accessdata.fda.gov/scripts/cder/ndc/index.cfm">https://www.accessdata.fda.gov/scripts/cder/ndc/index.cfm</a>)
- Medication referrals must include the requested NDC code
- Medication Referrals received without the NDC code will be returned for correction

## Payment to providers for Medi-Cal RX Effective 01/01/2022

- With the implementation of Medi-Cal RX, certain services carved out by the state are no longer Preferred IPA financial responsibility for any Medi-Cal health plan beginning in January 2022.
- Claims for Medi-Cal RX services for dates of service on or after 01/01/2022 will be denied as "not IPA financial responsibility".
- At this time there is no process for individual providers to be reimbursed through Medi-Cal RX, members must receive these services from Medi-Cal RX contracted pharmacies.
